

What is "the Japan - America Grassroots Summit?"

The Japan-America Grassroots Summit is a large-scale meeting for Japanese and American citizens held annually alternately in Japan and the United States to share the friendship fostered by the families of Nakahama Manjiro and the Captain William Whitfield. However, the Summit has been cancelled two years in a row due to the Covid pandemic since 2020.

To restart the Grassroots Summit that was interrupted by the disaster of the pandemic, small face-to-face international exchange programs are now being held, by those willing to make them happen. These efforts are stepping stones towards the resumption of regular Grassroots Summit in the future.

Whitfield rescued the marooned Manjiro in 1841 and welcomed him into his own home. Later, Manjiro's rare command of English and experience of America became pivotal to the Japan-U.S. relationship after Perry's arrival 1853.

Each year, Japanese prefectures and American states take turns as hosts for about a week, sharing their homes and the unique features of their communities. At these regular Grassroots Summits, over 100 people usually participate as guests, enjoying sight-seeing, cultural activities, welcoming and closing ceremonies, as well as staying with a host family.
