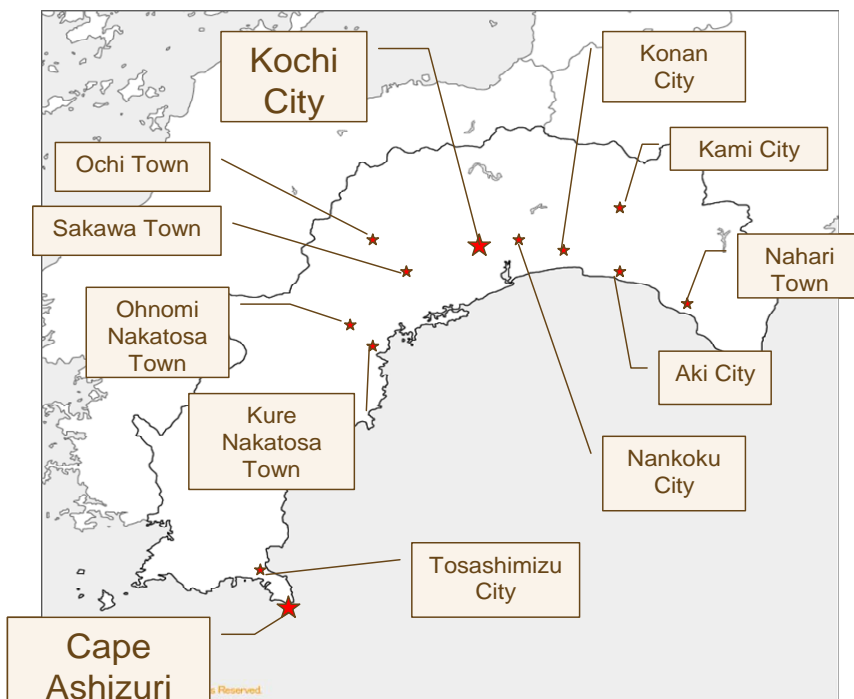


What is the Japan-America Grassroots Summit?

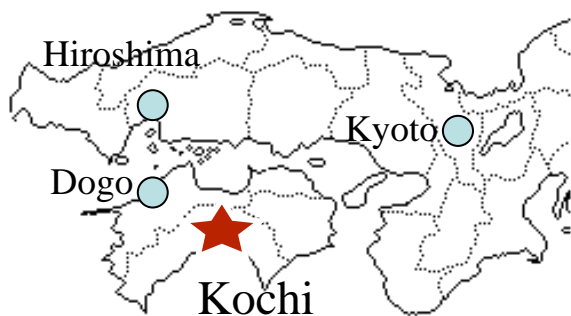
